



GUIDELINES

General Guidance and Regulations

- It is prohibited to release drugs and substances whose use is banned internationally and locally.
- It is prohibited to release the drugs listed in [Sub schedule A](#) and [Sub Schedule B of schedule 1](#), of Law No. 9 of 1987 on Control and Regulation of Narcotic Drugs and Dangerous Psychoactive Substances.
- If the prior approval wasn't obtained, travelers must declare their narcotic and psychotropic medications upon arrival at the country's ports along with the Prescription and Medical Report.
- Original medical report and prescription must be available upon request.

Clearance Conditions

It is allowed to clear drugs in possession of patients arriving to Qatar for personal use in accordance with the following terms:

A. Travelers must submit the following:

1. Prescription:

- Prescription should be in either English or Arabic language.
- Must include the patient's full name, controlled medication name with dosage and form, duration of treatment, issue date, and physician's name, signature and stamp.
- must be issued within the last 6 months and stamped/recognized by a healthcare facility.
- Must include abroad physician /clinic phone number

2. Medical Report:

- Medical Report should be in either English or Arabic language.
- Must include the patient's full name, diagnosis, treatment plan (medication name, dosage form, and treatment duration), issue date, and physician's name, signature and stamp.
- Must be issued within the last 6 months and stamped/recognized by the healthcare facility where the patient is following up.
- Must include abroad physician /clinic phone number

3. A copy of the patient's QID/Passport.

4. The patient must provide a signed undertaking letter confirming the medication is for personal use.

B. Allowed Quantities:

- Narcotic Medications: Allowed for maximum quantity enough for 10 days of prescribed medications.
- Psychotropic Medications: Allowed for maximum quantity enough for 60 days of prescribed medications.

Medication Refill in Qatar:

- If the permitted supply runs out, the patient must consult a licensed doctor in Qatar.
- If the doctor confirms continued treatment is necessary, a medical file must be opened at the same healthcare facility, and the medication should be prescribed and dispensed from local pharmacies if available.

Injectable Medications: Must be approved and supervised by a local healthcare facility and registered in the facility's records as per the regulations.
